Quantum Theory and Psychoanalytic Dialogue by **Jerry Gargiulo and Ruth Rosenbaum**

Quantum theory not only provides a useful framework for thinking about our concept of the unconscious, but also has implications for how and what we pay attention to when working with patients. Jerry Gargiulo will present some of the seemingly bizarre findings of quantum physics and will discuss how these findings relate to our understanding of the generic as well as the repressed unconscious. Ruth Rosenbaum will discuss additional aspects of quantum theory, and will show, using clinical vignettes, how quantum theory can be a helpful framework for facilitating change in patients' persistent psychological patterns. Discussion with the audience will follow.
